# TOUR ITINERARY

MAY 7 – 19, 2025

**DAY 1** WEDNESDAY, MAY 7: DEPART FOR ISRAEL

**DAY 2** THURSDAY, MAY 8: ARRIVE IN ISRAEL

Meet group at Tel Aviv Ben Gurion Airport Arrivals at 1:30 pm. **Overnight at the Leonardo Plaza hotel, Netanya.**

**DAY 3** FRIDAY, MAY 9: FROM THE MEDITERRANEAN SEA TO THE SEA OF GALILEE

1) Caesarea, Judea's ancient capital where the apostle Paul was imprisoned for two years 2) Mt. Carmel, with its breathtaking view of the Jezreel Valley (Armageddon) - where Elijah challenged the 450 false prophets of Baal 3) Mt. Precipice overlooking Nazareth - worship and prayer over Israel, 4) Go to hotel or visit Magdala Excavations (hometown of Mary Magdalene). **Overnight at Ron Beach Hotel in Galilee.**

**DAY 4** SATURDAY, MAY 10: GALILEE

Today is the Shabbat (Sabbath). Attend local church service. Take a worship boat ride across the Sea of Galilee with a Messianic captain. Then, option of returning to the hotel or visiting the Mt. of Beatitudes and time-permitting, Capernaum – the center of Jesus' ministry in the Galilee. **Overnight at Ron Beach.**

**DAY 5** SUNDAY, MAY 11: GOLAN HEIGHTS

We will take a two-hour jeep tour of the Golan Heights led by senior IDF intelligence officer and hopefully visit Kibbutz Malkia which experienced many hits early on by Hezbollah. Here, we will meet some of the IDF. If possible, we will host some Holocaust survivors for dinner at our hotel. Listen to their stories, enjoy music, share, maybe even dance! **Overnight at Ron Beach.**

**DAY 6** MONDAY, MAY 12: FROM THE SEA OF GALILEE TO THE DEAD SEA

1) Local, vibrant gift shop in the lower Galilee 2) Beit She'an - one of Israel's largest and most important archaeological sites from the time of King David. Repeat visitors have the option of visiting Gideon's Spring during this time. 3) Baptismal site on Jordan River for optional baptism and worship 4) Drive by Qumran - where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. 5) **Check into our beautiful hotel, Noga by Isrotel, overlooking the Dead Sea.**

**DAY 7** TUESDAY, MAY 13: FROM THE DEAD SEA TO JERUSALEM

Late, 10 am departure. Repeat visitors may want to linger at the hotel longer. 1) Explore the hillside fortress of Masada on the Dead Sea. 2) Hike Ein Gedi Nature Reserve where David hid in caves from King Saul. 3) Ascend to Mt Scopus for a scenic view and prayer over the entire city of Jerusalem. **Check into our luxurious Dan Jerusalem hotel.**

**DAY 8** WEDNESDAY, MAY 14: TEL AVIV AND AROUND GAZA

1) Nova Festival and kibbutzim near Gaza to love on, listen to, gain a greater understanding, pray for, and grieve with Israel - for what has been suffered since October 7, 2023. 2) Valley of Elah - setting of David and Goliath 3) If time permits, Yad Hashmona Messianic kibbutz. **Overnight at Dan Jerusalem.**

**DAY 9** THURSDAY, MAY 15: JERUSALEM

We will visit Tel Shiloh and view excavations of Israel's religious center and location of the Tabernacle for 369 years. Now also home to the red heifers who we will see, three are now qualified by rabbinic standards to be sacrificed in preparation for the coming, prophesied Third Temple. In the afternoon, we will tour the City of David: newest/ greatest biblical archaeological finds in Israel, including the Pool of Siloam. Hopefully, Jeff Morgan from SO BE IT! will share his ministry to the Jewish people to us in our hotel this evening. **Overnight at Dan Jerusalem.**

## DAY 10 FRIDAY, MAY 16: JERUSALEM

All day in Old City Jerusalem. **Free day for repeat visitors.** 1) Explore Southern Wall Excavations - extensive, Second Temple period archaeological discoveries. 2) Worship at the Southern Steps where Jesus likely taught. 3) Visit the Western Wall, the Jew's most holy site. Pray at the wall or place a written prayer between the stones. 4) Western Wall Tunnels - network of underground passageways from the Second Temple period 5) Pool of Bethesda, (John 5:2-9: Jesus healed the invalid 6) Via Dolorosa - "Way of the Cross" with 14 Stations representing key events in Jesus' journey to the cross 7) Lithostratos - second-century Roman flagstones, likely where Pilate brought Jesus for the final part of His trial 8) Holy Sepulchre Church – holiest place for Catholics, alternative site for Jesus' crucifixion and burial. **Everyone: Shabbat at the Western Wall at sunset - join hundreds of local Jews, the IDF, and tourists welcoming the Sabbath with prayers, singing, and dancing. Overnight at Dan Jerusalem.**

## DAY 11 SATURDAY, MAY 17: JERUSALEM

1) Mt. of Olives with its amazing views of the Old City and the beginning of Jesus' final path of suffering, where He ascended into heaven, and where He will stand at His Second Coming 2) At its foot, we visit the Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive trees, the actual site where Jesus agonized in prayer prior to His arrest. 3) We follow to where Jesus would have been arrested and taken as a prisoner to the High Priest Caiphas' House. 4) Communion and worship at the serene Garden Tomb, which many believe to be the authentic site of the crucifixion, burial and resurrection of Jesus. **Overnight at Dan Jerusalem.**

## DAY 12 SUNDAY, MAY 18: JERUSALEM

In the morning, we will visit the Israel Museum - original Isaiah scrolls and one-acre model of 2<sup>nd</sup> Temple period Jerusalem and the Friends of Zion Museum - story of Jews and gentiles working together to create a Jewish homeland experienced through groundbreaking technology OR enjoy downtown Jerusalem on Ben Yehuda St. In the afternoon, we will head over to Hostage Square in Tel Aviv and Jaffa where Jonah set sail, Simon the Tanner lived, and Peter had his vision of unclean animals. After this, we will host a dinner in the area for an IDF troop of soldiers. Many head to the airport this evening for their flight back home. **Let us know if you need another night at the Dan Jerusalem.**

## DAY 13 MONDAY, MAY 19: DEPART FOR USA
