MARCH 1 - 11, 2026

DAY 1 SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 28 (OR SOONER): DEPART FOR ISRAEL

SUNDAY, MARCH 1: MEET IN JAFFA/TEL AVIV AREA – CLICKABLE LINKS BELOW

Meet group at Kdumim Square <u>Jaffa</u> at 10 am. Tour Jaffa where Jonah set sail, Simon the Tanner lived, and Peter had his vision of unclean animals. Visit <u>Hostage Square</u> Tel Aviv. <u>Repeat visitors can visit the Palmach Museum</u> in Tel Aviv during the Jaffa tour. Overnight at the <u>Leonardo Plaza Hotel</u>, Netanya.

DAY 3 MONDAY, MARCH 2: FROM THE MEDITTERANEAN SEA TO THE SEA OF GALILEE

1) <u>Caesarea</u>, Judea's ancient capital where the apostle Paul was imprisoned for two years (repeat visitors can help prepare lunch for Holocaust Survivors during this time) 2) Host <u>lunch for Holocaust Survivors</u> in Caesarea 3) <u>Mt. Carmel</u>, with its breathtaking view of the Jezreel Valley (Armageddon) - where Elijah challenged the 450 false prophets of Baal 4) If time, <u>Mt. Precipice</u> overlooking Nazareth **Overnight at <u>Ron Beach Hotel</u> in Galilee.**

DAY 4 TUESDAY, MARCH 3: GALILEE OR GOLAN HEIGHTS

1) Visit <u>Magdala Excavations</u> to view Jewish life in first-century Galilee. 2) Continue to the <u>Mt. of Beatitudes</u>. Time-permitting, <u>Capernaum</u> – the center of Jesus' ministry in the Galilee. 3) Lunch at <u>Magdala Restaurant</u> on the shore of the Sea of Galilee. 4) Take a <u>worship boat cruise</u> across the Sea of Galilee with a Messianic captain. Repeat visitors can spend the day exploring behind-the-scenes in the Golan Heights with tour guide Eitan from Kibbutz Malkiya. **Overnight at Ron Beach Hotel.**

DAY 5 WEDNESDAY, MARCH 4: GOLAN HEIGHTS

1) Visit <u>Kibbutz Malkia</u> on the Lebanon border with tour guide/resident Eitan Oren. This kibbutz experienced many attacks early on by Hezbollah. Here, we will also meet some of the IDF. 2) Stop for lunch. 3) Take a two-hour jeep tour near the Syrian border led by senior IDF intelligence officer. **Overnight at Ron Beach Hotel.**

THURSDAY, MARCH 5: FROM THE SEA OF GALILEE TO JERUSALEM

1) Local, vibrant gift shop in the lower Galilee 2) Beit She'an - one of Israel's largest and most important archaeological sites from the time of King David. Repeat visitors have the option of visiting Gideon's Spring during this time. 3) Qasr el Yahud baptismal site on Jordan River for optional baptism and worship. 4) Mt. Scopus with a breathtaking view of Jerusalem. 5) Check into our luxurious Dan Jerusalem Hotel.

DAY 7 FRIDAY, MARCH 6: OLD CITY JERUSALEM

Visit the Western Wall, the Jew's most holy site. Pray at the wall or place a written prayer between the stones.

2) Western Wall Tunnels - network of underground passageways from the Second Temple period 3) Pool of Bethesda, (John 5:2-9: Jesus healed the invalid 4) Via Dolorosa - "Way of the Cross" with 14 Stations representing key events in Jesus' journey to the cross 5) Lithostratos - second-century Roman flagstones, likely where Pilate brought Jesus for the final part of His trial 6) Holy Sepulchre Church - holiest place for Catholics, alternative site for Jesus' crucifixion and burial. 7) Free time for shopping in Old City. Repeat visitors have the option of exploring Ammunition Hill, a national memorial and museum dedicated to the 1967 Six-Day War. Then visit several fascinating destinations in the Old City: the Tower of David Museum, the Christ Church historical Heritage Centre, and the Ramparts Walk above and around the Old City. 8) Shabbat at the Western Wall at sunset - join hundreds of local Jews, the IDF, and tourists welcoming the Sabbath with prayers, singing, and dancing. Overnight at Dan Jerusalem.

DAY 8 SATURDAY, MARCH 7: AROUND OLD CITY JERUSALEM

1) Mt. of Olives with its amazing views of the Old City and the beginning of Jesus' final path of suffering, where He ascended into heaven, and where He will stand at His Second Coming; 2) Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive trees, the actual site where Jesus agonized in prayer prior to His arrest; 3) We follow to where Jesus would have been arrested and taken as a prisoner to the High Priest Caiphas' House; 4) Communion and worship at the serene Garden Tomb, which many believe to be the authentic site of the crucifixion, burial and resurrection of Jesus. Optional full or partial FREE DAY for repeat visitors. Overnight at Dan Jerusalem.

DAY 9 SUNDAY, MARCH 8: JERUSALEM

1) Yad Vashem Holocaust Museum; 2) Lunch stop in Mahane Yehuda, Jerusalem's largest and most famous market; 3) Israel Museum - original Isaiah scrolls and one-acre model of Second Temple period Jerusalem; 4) Friends of Zion Museum - the story of Jews and gentiles working together to create a Jewish homeland experienced through groundbreaking technology. Repeat visitors have a late hotel departure at 11:30 am. They can then head to Mahane Yehuda Marketplace for lunch and browsing. After, they can take an extensive tour of the Knesset, Israel's Parliament headquarters, where they will learn about the election process, the roles of Knesset members, and the work of the committees. Overnight at Dan Jerusalem.

DAY 10 MONDAY, MARCH 9: AROUND OLD CITY JERUSALEM

1) IF possible, we will meet <u>Yehuda Glick</u> for a **Temple Mount** tour at 7 am. Yehuda is an orthodox rabbi and former Knesset Member who campaigns for expanding Jewish access to the Temple Mount. 2) Then we will spend most of the day guided by <u>Eli Shukron</u>, the City of David's foremost archaeologist, who founded the Pool of Siloam and the Pilgrim Road leading from the <u>City of David</u> to the Temple Mount. Eli will take us behind the scenes and follow the Pilgrim Road to the <u>Southern Wall excavations</u>. Worship at the Southern Steps where Jesus likely taught. 3) Hopefully, <u>Boaz Michael</u> of First Fruits of Zion Ministry will give us a private tour of <u>Mount Zion</u> with its fascinating historical backstory. **Overnight at Dan Jerusalem.**

DAY 11 TUESDAY, MARCH 10: FROM JERUSALEM TO THE DEAD SEA

1) Drive by <u>Qumran</u>, the site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. 2) Hike <u>Ein Gedi Nature Reserve</u> with its beautiful waterfalls and the place where David hid in caves from King Saul. 3) Explore the famous hillside fortress of <u>Masada</u> built by King Herod as a palace complex. Masada was the last stand of the Jews in 70 AD before the destruction of Jerusalem, the Holy Temple, and the expansion of the Diaspora. **Check into the lavish** <u>Isrotel Noga hotel</u> <u>overlooking the Dead Sea.</u>

DAY 12 WEDNESDAY, MARCH 11: DEAD SEA / MEMORIALS TO OCTOBER 7 VICTIMS / TEL AVIV

Late departure at 10 am to enjoy Dead Sea and spa. 1) <u>Fountain of Tears</u> – a masterful, heart-rending monument and story in the wilderness to the Holocaust survivors and Yeshua. 2) Visit to the Gaza Envelope to experience the site of the October 7 massacre - the <u>Nova Festival</u> grounds, <u>kibbutzim</u>, and more. Pay tribute to, grieve, listen to, and gain a greater understanding of how to pray for a mourning nation. 3) Final meal together; we will host an IDF troop for dinner. Some will head out to the airport this evening.

DAY 13 THURSDAY, MARCH 12: DEPART FOR USA
